...What you need to know

The 2018 Nishnawbe Aski Food Symposium will be held from July 31st – August 2nd at Grey Wolf Scout Camp, a large wilderness area just 15 km southwest of the Thunder Bay airport.

Cost:

- Full sponsorships available to all youth (25 and under), Elders and the first 20 general registrants - *includes registration fee, meals, accommodation & travel (booked by NAN)*
- General registration fee: \$300 per individual - *includes meals & accommodations **but not travel***
- If not being sponsored for travel, you must arrange your own travel;
If booking with Wasaya, call 1-877-492-7292 and mention conference code *NANFS18* to receive 25% off full fares to Sioux Lookout and 40% off full fares to Thunder Bay
If booking with North Star Air, call 1-844-633-6294 and mention the *NAN Food Symposium* to receive 15-25% off based on origin of travel
- Please note that registration is not complete without a cheque payable to Nishnawbe Aski Nation

Registration:

- Registration will take place from 7-8 pm on Monday, July 30th and from 7:30-9 am on Tuesday, July 31st at the Nor'Wester

- Registrations received after July 9th, 2018 will be based on available spaces

Accommodations:

- There are three accommodation options for Tuesday & Wednesday:
 - (1) Grey Wolf Scout Camp bunks (up to 40 available) in shared cabins – ideal for youth; sleeping bag and mat provided
 - (2) Grey Wolf Scout Camp tenting space – a limited number of tents available from NAN; sleeping bag and mat provided
 - (3) Best Western PLUS Nor'Wester Hotel & Conference Centre – shuttles provided
- **All attendees** arriving in Thunder Bay on Monday, July 30th and departing on Friday, August 3rd will have hotel rooms booked at *Best Western PLUS Nor'Wester Hotel & Conference Centre* for Monday and Thursday night. Those who select on site accommodation will stay on site Tuesday and Wednesday night.

Meals:

- All meals will be provided on symposium dates (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday); cheques for travel meals will also be provided by NAN (to be picked up at symposium)

Transportation:

- Travel to and from Thunder Bay will be arranged by NAN; individuals are asked to provide travel details in the registration form
- A bus charter will run from the Nor'Wester to Grey Wolf each morning and from Grey Wolf to Nor'Wester each evening
- In the event that you must cancel/reschedule any travel arrangements due to weather or unexpected issues, please notify us as soon as possible

Consider packing:

- Weather appropriate clothing (including rain gear)
- Toiletries (NAN will provide eco friendly bar soap, bug spray, lip balm and sunscreen)
- Pillow, sleeping bag, sleeping mat (only if staying in on-site bunks/tents; NAN *will* provide camping gear for those who do not bring their own)
- A copy of a favourite family recipe
- Community food (grown, harvested, etc.) to trade or display
- Musical instruments

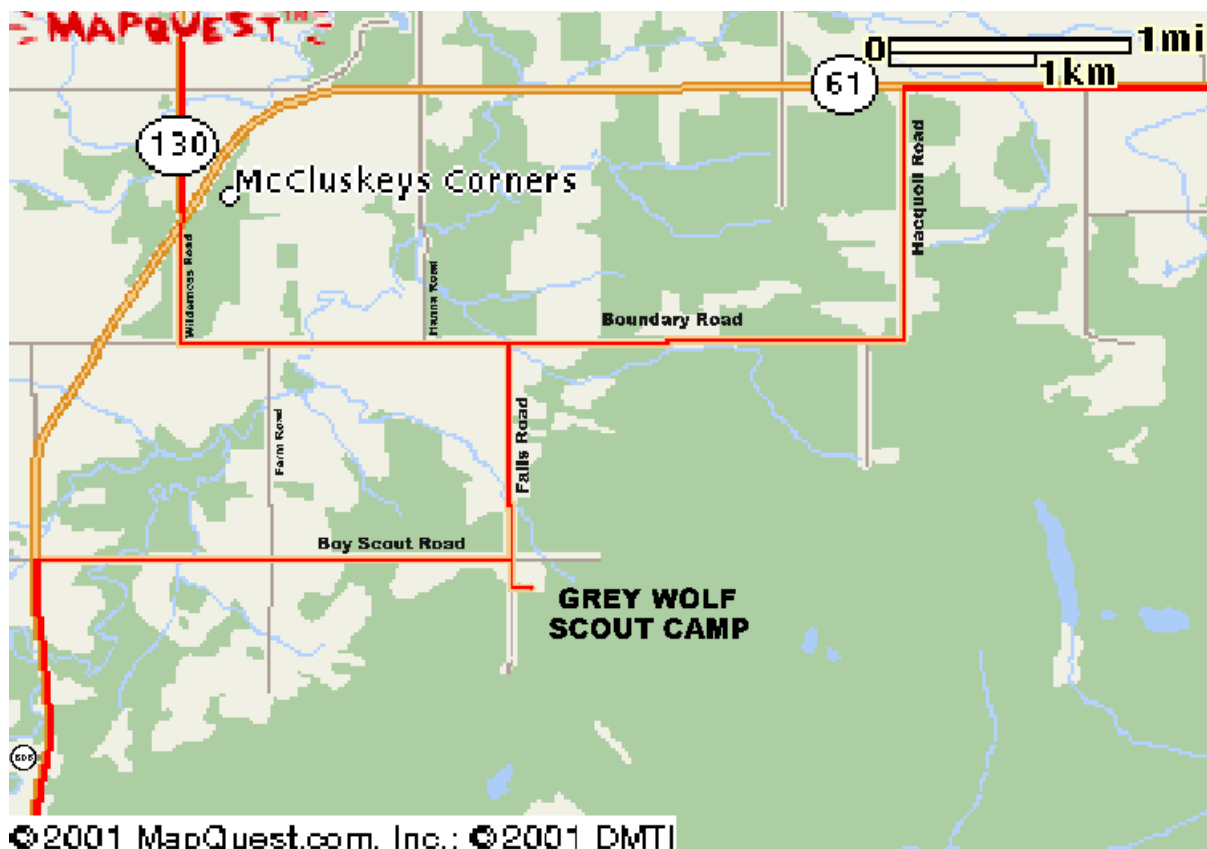
How to get there:

From the junction of Highways 11-17, 61, and Arthur Street:

- South on Highway 61, 10.5 Km to Hacquoil Road
- Turn Left (South) on Hacquoil Road, travel South 2 Km;
- Right onto Boundary Drive, travel West 2.7 Km;
- Turn Left on Falls Road, travel South 1.7 Km.
- Grey Wolf gate is just South of the first intersection, (Boy Scout Road) on Falls Road.

From the West on Highway 11-17:

- 14 Km East of Kakabeka Falls, (and East of the weigh scales) turn South on Highway 130;
- Travel South (and West) 12.5 Km to Junction Highway 61.
- Turn right onto Highway 61 and immediately left onto Wilderness Road;
- Travel South 1 Km to Boundary Road;
- Turn left, travel 2 Km East to Falls Road;
- Turn right (South) onto Falls Road, travel South 1.7 Km.
- Grey Wolf gate is just South of the intersection, (Boy Scout Road) on Falls Road.
